### If you have Medicare and Medicaid

<b>Between</b> \$1,225 and \$1,361 (\$1,655 to 1,839 for couples) per month in 2011	<b>Below</b> \$12,640 (\$25,260 for couples) in 2011 <sup>1</sup>	<b>Partial Extra Help</b> Premium depends on your income \$63 deductible or the plan's standard deductible, whichever is cheaper	15% coinsurance or the plan copay, whichever is less After \$6,447.50 in total drug costs, you pay \$2.50/generic and \$6.30/brand-name or 5% of the drug cost, whichever is greater

<sup>1</sup>Asset limits include \$1,500 per person for burial expenses.

<sup>2</sup>You pay no premium if you have Full Extra Help and a basic Part D drug plan with a premium at or below the Extra Help premium limit for your area.
