We understand this coverage is set to expire with the COVID-19 public health emergency (PHE). We respectfully ask CMS to consider extending it. Doing so would best ensure older adults and people with disabilities remain equipped to monitor their health and empowered to act accordingly, including by seeking treatment at the first signs of illness.
